The Rev'd Shawn McCain **Tuesday, October 3, 1:30-4pm**

Shawn is an Anglican priest and the founding rector of Resurrection South Austin in the Diocese of Churches for the Sake of Others (C4SO). He is on the leadership team for the ACNA's church planting initiative, Always Forward, and a co-founder of "35 for 35", a cross-jurisdictional church planting initiative in Central Texas.



The Rev'd Katie Nakamura Rengers **Tuesday, October 24, 1:30-4pm**

Katie is the mission developer and priest-in-charge of the Abbey, an Episcopal church and coffee shop in Birmingham, AL. She previously served as rector of St. Michael's in Fayette, AL and as Associate Rector for young adults at St. Luke's in Birmingham, AL. She is a member of the Episcopal Church's Church Planting Task Force.



The Rev'd Mike Michie **Tuesday, November 7, 1:30-4pm**

Mike is the Episcopal Church's Staff Officer for Church Planting Infrastructure, a member of the Church Planting Task Force, and the president of the Standing Committee in the Diocese of Dallas. Previously, he served as the rector of St. Andrew's in McKinney, TX, a congregation he planted. During his tenure, the congregation grew to a 650 member church, with a series of successful community-based ministries.



The Rev'd Joel & Mrs. Tammy Prather **Tuesday, November 28, 1:30-4pm**

Joel and Tammy planted Church of the Savior in Allen, TX (Diocese of Dallas) in 2010, after which they were called to Christ Church to revitalize a historic parish in Delavan, WI. The Prather's ministry emphasis is "pastoral evangelism" building relationships between business and faith, and the Anglo and Latino communities for the good of Delavan and the Kingdom of God.
