

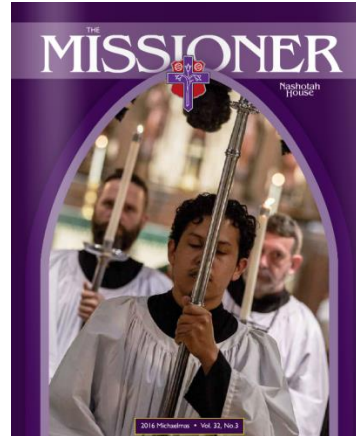

## Nashotah House 2016 Award Recipients Announced

NASHOTAH, WISCONSIN, (March 31, 2016) – Nashotah House is proud to announce its 2016 Leadership Award recipients. Awards will be presented at the Alumni Awards Banquet to be held on Campus during Homecoming, Wednesday, May 25, 2016. *The Archbishop Ramsey Award* is presented to an individuals who distinguish themselves in the areas Ecclesiology, Ecumenism, Ascetic Spiritual Theology, or Priestly Formation and Liturgy. This year's recipient is *The Rt. Rev. Harold Miller*, Bishop of Down & Dromore, The Church of Ireland. Bishop Miller will be presenting the Arthur Michael Ramsey Lecture as a sermon at the Homecoming Day Evensong.

*The Bishop McKim Award* is presented to individuals who demonstrate distinguished leadership in international service. This year's recipient is *The Rt. Rev. Francis C. Gray DD '87*. Bishop Gray, retired Bishop of Northern Indiana, has a long and distinguished history of International Mission work.

*The Bishop Kemper Award* is presented to individuals who distinguish themselves as leaders in service to the broader Church. This year's recipient is *The Rev. Canon Nelson W. Pinder DD '04*. Canon Pinder, a determined advocate for increasing diversity, led the peaceful integration of Orlando's community during the Civil Rights Era.

*The Father Breck Distinguished Service Award* is presented to individuals who distinguish themselves in outstanding service to the House and embody the spirit and vision of Breck. This year two recipients have been selected, *The Rev. Canon H.W. Herrmann SSC MDiv '89* and *The Rev. Canon Edward R. Monk SSC MDiv '99*. Fathers Herrmann and Monk have provided dedicated service to Nashotah House, the Alumni Association, and have assisted with the renewal of the House's governance structure.

Other Homecoming highlights will include:

- The Ambrose Institute Program “**Culture, Catechesis and Congregation: Gathering In, Going Out**”, presented by The Rev. Dr. Jack Gabig, Director of the Institute and Associate Professor of Practical Theology and The Rev. Lee Nelson, Ambrose Coach and Rector, Christ Church (Waco, TX).
- **Arthur Michael Ramsey Lecture** to be presented during evensong as a sermon by The Rt. Rev. Harold Miller, Bishop of Down & Dromore, The Church of Ireland.
