DIPLOMA IN ANGLICAN STUDIES (DAS)

Formed for Ministry

The Diploma in Anglican Studies (DAS) focuses on the elements of theological training which are distinctive to the Anglican tradition. Students seeking admission to the DAS will ordinarily hold a Master of Divinity or its equivalent. This certificate is designed for those who are seeking to supplement their training, perhaps to meet requirements for ordination in an Anglican or Episcopal context. The DAS can be completed in one academic year.
