The Master of Divinity (MDiv) is a first professional theological degree intended for persons pursuing ordination in the Anglican tradition, but welcomes lay ministers, the theologically interested, and members of other denominations as well. Our most comprehensive degree, the MDiv is a residential program which generally requires three years to complete and yields invaluable preparation for those desiring to engage in pastoral ministry. The MDiv offers courses in areas of competency required for ordination in the Episcopal Church, the Anglican Church in North America, and other continuing Anglican bodies
